Nominees should be leaders at international departments, programs, or divisions at USCIPP member organizations. Nominees for the Award must be actively engaged in the field and use their influence to positively shape the industry. Self-nominations are not eligible.

The recipient of the **2020 INTERNATIONAL SERVICES LEADERSHIP AWARD** will be honored on the evening of **Thursday, June 18, 2020**, in conjunction with the USCIPP annual meeting in Philadelphia.

Has made significant contributions to USCIPP, such as demonstrating strong leadership on/to (a) USCIPP project(s) or initiative(s), providing dedicated service within USCIPP's committee structure (Advisory Council/Benchmarking & Analytics/Education & Conference), showing commitment to the spirit of interorganizational learning and collaboration, providing strategic guidance and support for the association (past or present), etc.
2. Demonstrates strong leadership practices by serving as a role model, mentoring others, and creating (a) high-performing team(s)
3. Offers perspective, guidance, and direction in the field of international patient services to expand global access to US expertise in high-quality healthcare
4. Has achieved measurable improvements in organizational performance and value
5. Recognized and respected within the field and uses this influence to positively shape the industry
